

# *A Declaration*

To all persons who should see these presents, greetings. I, the undersigned, do hereby give notice of, and call attention to, egregious acts against the Constitution of the United States of America. Having sworn allegiance to, and pledged my life to the protection of, this sacred document it has come to pass that we Free People must declare our open intentions to Defend these Principles in any manner deemed necessary to ensure the everlasting Light of Freedom is never extinguished.

Having witnessed a litany of usurpations of the Bill of Rights specifically, as well as other Articles and Amendments of the Constitution, I and those that so choose to freely sign themselves to this document, Declare that a reasonable course of action should be taken to remedy the Acts listed below. Should such remedy not be immediately undertaken there shall exist between those Opposed an open state of Civil War until said time that Law and Order in accordance with the Constitution of the United States of America has been reestablished.

It is our sincere objective to resolve these differences in a peaceful manner. However, it is clear throughout the course of History that Freedoms have never been gained through inaction and tolerance of the oppression levied against all persons given Rights to make all manner of decisions affecting the course of their natural life.

Find herein the following Rights and those Acts Against them:

## **Article III - Section II**

*The judicial Power shall extend to all Cases, in Law and Equity, arising under this Constitution, the Laws of the United States, and Treaties made, or which shall be made, under their Authority;—to all Cases affecting Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls;—to all Cases of admiralty and maritime Jurisdiction;—to Controversies to which the United States shall be a Party;—to Controversies between two or more States;— between a State and Citizens of another State,—between Citizens of different States,—between Citizens of the same State claiming Lands under Grants of different States, and between a State, or the Citizens thereof, and foreign States, Citizens or Subjects.*

### Those Acts Against

Having misapplied established law set forth by Legislators of the State the disenfranchisement of citizens has been recorded and reported by Objecting States to the Supreme Court and so disregarded without evidentiary review

## **Article IV Section IV**

*The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government, and shall protect each of them against Invasion; and on Application of the Legislature, or of the Executive (when the Legislature cannot be convened) against domestic Violence.*

### Those Acts Against

State authorities violated the Peace by allowing prolonged Acts of Violence to occur without taking appropriate measures to ensure domestic tranquility

State authorities violated the Sovereignty of the nation by allowing the existence of Autonomous Zones

## **Amendment I**

*Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances.*

### Those Acts Against

State mandated closures of places of worship while permitting large gatherings for entertainment and commerce

Corporate actions against legal platforms primarily established to disseminate personal beliefs and public information

State mandated restrictions of lawful assembly of citizens within publicly funded properties and private businesses

## **Amendment II**

*A well-regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.*

### Those Acts Against

Restrictions placed to legally obtain and ability to maintain possession of, in public, of arms commonly in use by the State

## **Amendment IV**

*The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.*

### Those Acts Against

Political targeting of individuals by national law enforcement and regulatory agencies through suppression of evidence of innocence

## **Amendment V**

*No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a grand jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the militia, when in actual service in time of war or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offense to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation.*

### Those Acts Against

Procurement of private property by the State against the objection of the owner for the purpose of corporate commercial interests

## **Amendment VI**

*In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the state and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the assistance of counsel for his defense.*

Those Acts Against

Extended trials of political opponents with the sole objective of the ordeal to be financial ruin

The refusal to compel public appearance of accusers during public hearings

**Amendment VIII**

*Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.*

Those Acts Against

Fines levied against corporations and individuals are not relative, being of a greater effect on net wealth to lower income individuals while their crimes are often limited to far fewer victims

The aforementioned shall not be construed as a complete and final accounting of grievances and may be amended as deemed appropriate by the undersigned.
